| AZ-31-1 | Junction of Cactus Forest Drive, entrance to the Rincon Mountain developed area and visitor center, with South Old Spanish Trail. View looking southeast, across South Old Spanish Trail, into the park along Cactus Forest Drive. The low stone wall to the left defines an earlier road alignment that featured a sweeping right turn exit lane from Cactus Forest Drive. A similar low wall extends south of the entrance monument sign, pictured to the right of Cactus Forest Drive. December 2023 |
| AZ-31-2 | Junction of Cactus Forest Drive, entrance to the Rincon Mountain developed area and visitor center, with South Old Spanish Trail. View looking south. March 2025 |
| AZ-31-3 | Close-up view of the low stone wall that defines an earlier road alignment that featured a sweeping right turn exit lane from Cactus Forest Drive onto South Old Spanish Trail. View looking south-southeast. December 2023 |

- AZ-31-6 View of Cactus Forest Drive looking into the Rincon Mountain Visitor Center parking area from the intersection of Cactus Forest Drive with the Service Road leading to the administration and residence area. View looking east. December 2023
- AZ-31-7 Rincon Mountain Visitor Center and parking from the entrance to the parking area. View looking northeast. The fee/entrance booth to the Cactus Forest Drive one-way loop road is visible at the opposite end of the parking area, right of center. December 2023
- AZ-31-8 South elevation and public entrance, Rincon Mountain Visitor Center; view looking north. March 2025
- AZ-31-9 Rincon Mountain Visitor Center and parking from the east end of the parking area. View looking northwest. The fee/entrance booth to the Cactus Forest Drive one-way loop road is just out of view to the right. December 2023

- AZ-31-15 Commencement of the Cactus Forest Drive one-way loop, approximately 130 feet east-northeast from the entrance/fee booth. One-way traffic continues to the left; returning traffic enters the intersection from the right. View looking northeast. March 2025
- AZ-31-16 Detail of the monument sign at the beginning of the Cactus Forest Drive one-way loop. View looking east-northeast. December 2023
- AZ-31-17 Wildlife pond on the north side of the Visitor Center. View looking southeast. March 2025
